- Recruit 12 judges who agree to judge all the competitions, print and projected image or 4 judging panels of 3 for 10 competitions. One Shot will be handled by a different judging group.
 - Elizabeth Benz will keep the master sheet of judges and judging dates. Any changes will need to go through Elizabeth.
- 4 Moderators who agree to moderate all competitions except for One Shot.
- Judges will have the categories and criteria on an evaluation form that they can use to pre-score images at home for projected images.
- Judging will occur live using a 100-point scoring rubric.
- Print competition will occur live. Judges to be at the club at 6:15.
- Judges will use the 12 Elements for the judging criteria.
- Club will use current ribbons until used up instead of buying new ribbons.
