Submission guidelines:

- Deadline for images is Tuesday, January 16. Email your image files with Subject = 125th to <u>pccupload@gmail.com</u>. Every submission receives a confirmation within 72 hours.
- One or two images per member. JPEG format only. Images should not exceed maximum width 1920px and maximum height 1080px.
- Name your image files in the format your name-title.jpg, for example, Ansel-Adams-Portland-Harbor-Sunrise.jpg

During the jury process, the Exhibit Committee will view all images with the makers' names hidden. The jury will choose 5 images on Jan 20. The 5 makers will be notified and have from Jan 20 through Jan 26 to prepare 2 items:

- 1. A high resolution image file for the final print. Additional details will be sent regarding the final, high resolution files.
- 2. A letter sized print of the image for Hunts Photo to use as a reference when they make the final print.
